Overview

Edens Landing State School in the fast-growing Logan area required a building solution that would allow it to cater to an increasing student population while maximizing outdoor space. Fleetwood Australia provided four new modern classrooms that not only addressed those needs but were delivered rapidly, enabling students and staff at Edens Landing to transition smoothly into the 2024 school year.

The new modular buildings fit in nicely with the school's branding and also addressed a key topographical challenge, preserving important outdoor space in the process.

Solution

Fleetwood managed all aspects of this project - from design to manufacturing, installation, service connections, and an electrical upgrade - providing a solution that maximizes Edens Landing State School's land use. A previous plan would have placed a permanent structure in a play area, but Fleetwood's innovative modular solutions allowed for an alternative location, preserving valuable recreational space.

The project included:

- 4 classrooms with teaching walls, breakout spaces, and a teacher resource room
- Modular building on a hill with a problem-solving layout
- Custom-designed cladding matching the school's colors
- Large outdoor covered learning area with astroturf
- 9-week accelerated delivery before the 2024 school

Benefits

The key benefits of the project include the preservation of outdoor recreational space by positioning the modular building over a hill, rapid delivery within four months ensuring readiness for the 2024 school year, minimal on-site disruptions due to off-site manufacturing techniques, high-quality results through controlled manufacturing conditions, and positive feedback from the school and Department of Education for the customized and timely solution.
