OVERVIEW

Fleetwood Australia partnered with Coomera Anglican College to deliver a modern Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) facility, addressing the growing need for after-school services. The project required maintaining ongoing operations while enhancing safety and supervision. Located along a main road, the facility needed to blend with existing architecture and meet fire safety standards.



SOLUTION

The facility comprises 15 modular units, featuring purpose-built spaces designed for both functionality and aesthetics. Key features include:

- Large floor-to-ceiling glass panels for enhanced supervision and safety
- Child-friendly amenities, including accessible toilets and breakout spaces
- Reception, staff room, kitchen, and office areas to support operations
- Multiple verandahs and a disability access ramp for accessibility

Construction was carried out in phases to minimise disruption. Fleetwood completed the project within 28 weeks, with only 11 weeks on-site and 4 weeks for demolition works.



BENEFITS

Enhanced Supervision and Safety:

The design prioritises child safety through the inclusion of floor-to-ceiling glass panels, which provide supervisors with clear sightlines across all activity zones.

Child-friendly amenities, including easily accessible toilets, breakout areas, and safe pathways, enhance the overall functionality and safety of the space.

Architectural and Compliance Integration:

The new facility integrates seamlessly with the school's existing architectural design, maintaining a visually appealing presence along a key thoroughfare.

Fleetwood implemented cost-effective fire compliance measures, eliminating the need for expensive infrastructure upgrades while ensuring safety regulations were fully met.
